REMEMBER cars not only slide around corners, they send a shower of stones and rocks out behind them as the power goes on. If you are in the firing line you can get hurt so stand where you are safe.

The Spectator Safety Officer car will come through the tests ahead of the competitors. Be aware that if you, or others, are in an unsafe position, or are continuing to ignore the marshals' instructions, the Safety Officer has the authority to delay the test, and in an extreme situation, request its cancellation.

The MSA provide general guidance as to the unsafe areas where spectators should not position themselves.

Don't:

- Stand on the track
- Stand below the level of the track
- Stand in front of arrows or signs
- Stand in Prohibited Areas
- Stand or sit on or near log piles, walls or fences
- Sit close to the edge of the track
- Block escape routes
- Be distracted
- Play games with your safety or that of the drivers
- Remove signs or arrows
- Be the one to stop the test

Always:

- Expect the unexpected
- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Try to keep behind something solid
- Keep children under supervision
- Keep dogs on a lead
- Do as the Marshals ask
- Help the Marshals to run a safe test

Be Sure That:

- The unexpected can happen
- If you ignore Marshals instructions, the test will be stopped

Special Test - Chapel Road (Glen Aros) - Car Park A	First Run 10.10 am
Special Test - Ledmore (Glen Aros) - Car Park B	First Run 10.15 am
Special Test - Mornish Haul Road - Car Park C	11.15 am
Lunch Break, meet the crews - Duart Castle	12.45 am
Special Test - Chapel Road (Glen Aros) - Car Park A	Second Run 3.10 pm

#### Chapel Road (Glen Aros Forest) Special Test

**Car Park A** – enter the forest off the A848 as shown on the map, turn left then left again (follow the green arrows) then park at the side of the forest road and walk down to the junction.

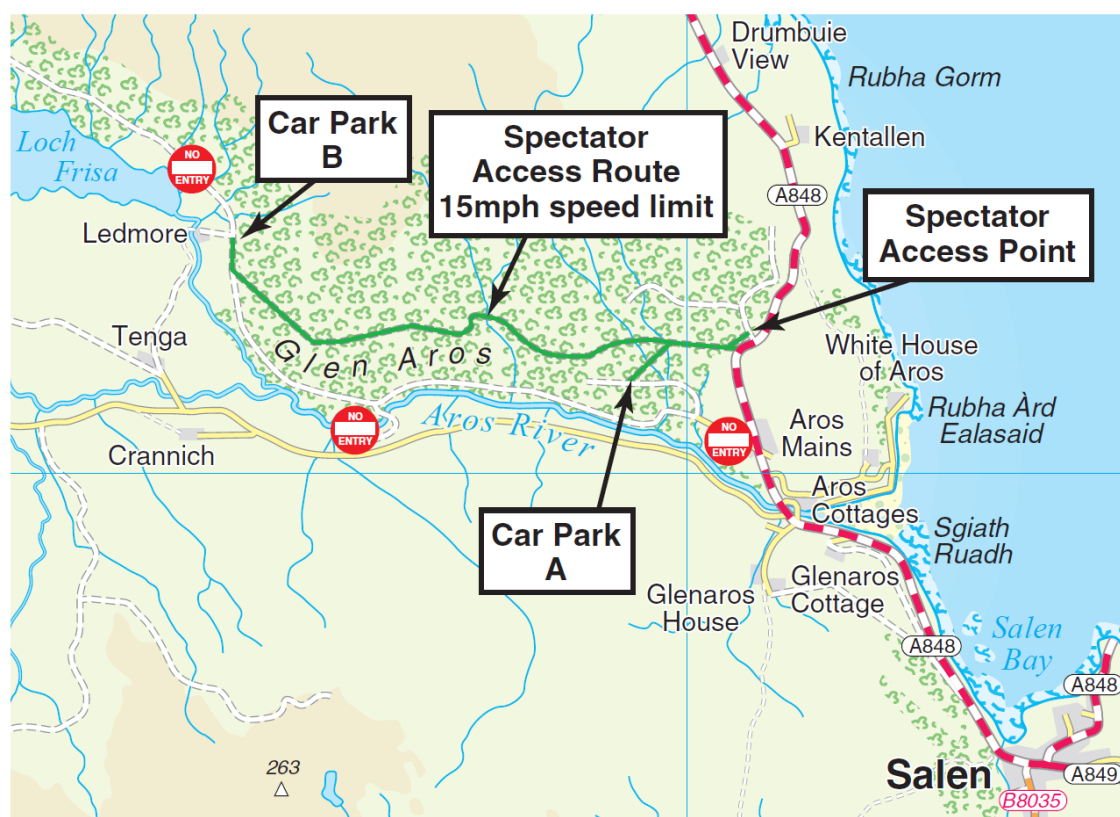
Spectator Viewing point – there is a good view of the cars climbing the bumpy chapel road before executing a turn round a cone in the junction and heading off down the new road to finish the test. This test is run twice, once in the morning and once in the afternoon.

#### Ledmore (Glen Aros Forest) Special Test

**Car Park B** – enter the forest off the A848 as shown on the map, turn left then straight on past the entrance to Car Park A (follow the green arrows), follow the forest road for about 2 miles (maximum speed 15mph) then park on the forest road and walk down to the junction. Please ensure the road is kept clear for through traffic.

Spectator Viewing point – For spectators there is a good view of the cars climbing the bumpy track up through the field before executing a stop astride at the finish line. This test is run twice, once in the morning and once in the afternoon.

**There is no access from the B8073 / Loch Frisa road – you will be turned away.**

## Mornish Haul Road Special Test

**Car Park C – (Mornish)** is off the B8073 road from Dervaig to Calgary, 1 mile West of the Croig junction. Please park on the North side of the B8073 on the Langamull Forest road, then walk towards the test start in the Haul Road. You will find direction to a path leading to the spectating zone. This access is NOT advisable for young children or anyone with difficulty in walking. The pathway is very uneven and muddy, therefore pushchairs and buggies would need to be carried. Restriction of movement to and from spectating zone may be implemented while the test is live.

From this point, you can watch the cars executing a “360” round a set of cones, then attempting the more open sections through a chicane, across the bridge and accelerating up the hill. This test is run once, in the morning.

**There is no access from the West Ardhru / Hill Road end – you will be turned away.**
