Dear Resident,

Beatson's Building Supplies Mull Rally – 13th - 15th October 2023

We are delighted to be back for this the 51st running of Mull's annual rally event. Please take the time to familiarise yourselves with the information below. If you are new to Mull, and haven't experienced the rally weekend before, please make yourselves aware of what happens.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our plans for the 2023 Beatson's Building Supplies Mull Rally and give you some advice to be followed during the event. Every year that the rally runs it can only be done with your support and co-operation. We gratefully rely on the residents along the route of the stages for their contribution to the safe running of the event.

Included in this information booklet is both a list and maps giving the route and timings of this year's event. The event includes road closures which are the subject of both a Temporary Traffic Restriction Order and Motor Sport Order. The roads are closed to people, animals and vehicles, unless authorised.

We are using roads that have been used in previous years, but the timing of the event is different, so expect more daytime closures. There are no closures in Tobermory itself, and access is maintained at all times to Rockfield and Glengorm. The Tobermory spectator area is further west and is accessible by foot or car via Sgriob-ruadh Farm.

The road closures are as listed. If you have guests or let a property, please can you ensure they have this information. Please plan ahead if you need to access locations affected. The road closes at the times listed, and this is backed up by a vehicle clearly marked "ROAD CLOSED" with red flashing lights, whereupon tape is tied to gate posts which should not be broken. The road will reopen using a vehicle clearly marked vehicle "ROAD OPEN" – the road may open earlier (or by police exception, later) than the time listed, so ensure you have seen the opening vehicle pass before using the road.

This information can also be found on the event website – www.mullrally.org where you can also find contact details for the senior officials along with other general information. From Thursday 12th October and over the weekend of the rally, if you have any questions or problems during the preparation and set up, the Stage Commander will be pleased to help you, and their contact details are given below.

When the road past your property is closed for the running of the stage, if you have an emergency and require assistance from the emergency services, please dial 999 or 112 as normal, **but you must tell the operator that the road is closed for the Rally.** Please also contact the Rally Control on the emergency number given at the bottom of the page. Rally Control has members of the emergency services present.

If you have no telephone - go ON FOOT to the nearest phone, or to a Marshal, who will be at the junction nearest your home. DO NOT walk on the road, as the Stage may be active. Tell the Marshal what your problem is, and he will communicate your problem to the Rally Control by the rally radio network.

This is the only way the Rally can be stopped - so please use the procedure as outlined above if the need arises.

We would also ask for your co-operation with the following during the road closure:

- Do not attempt to drive or cycle on the road as you may be putting your life and that of others in extreme danger.
- Ensure that any animals, especially dogs and horses, are safely kept away from the road.
- Ensure that any vehicles & machinery belonging to you is kept well clear of the road.
- Inform any possible visitors to your home who may not be aware of the Road Closure Times. e.g. milkman, doctor, vet, etc.

Mull Rally is an established and iconic event in the island calendar – we appreciate your patience during the two days that we deliver the event. We recognise these closures cause an inconvenience to residents and visitors and we try to manage these to minimise disruption. Again, we thank you for your co-operation and we will endeavour to keep your inconvenience to a minimum, and hope you enjoy the weekend.


