# SAFETY & OFFICIAL CARS

What you should know and look out for!



## RED BEACONS

### “Road CLOSURE Car”

You must be in position so we can start the rally. You are no longer allowed to walk on the road.



## AMBER BEACONS

### “Safety Cars”

## BLUE BEACONS

RESCUE, DOCTORS,  
PARAMEDICS, POLICE,



## Amber or No BEACONS

A “SWEEPER” or “INTER” Car may require to traverse the route. They are **NOT** opening the road. You are still not allowed to walk on the road.



## RED BEACONS

### “Road OPENING Car”

\*\*\*This and only this car declares the road open again for you to be able to move.\*\*\*

**Beatson's Building Supplies Mull Rally      10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

We are delighted to be staging the iconic Mull Rally again this year, a sporting challenge that dates back to 1969! This is a closed road event and may therefore impact your plans or movements. Please take time to familiarise yourselves with the information contained here. If you have not been on Mull during the Rally weekend before, please make yourselves aware of how the Rally works.

**Following a rock fall at Gribun at the start of August, we have made a number of revisions to the original route first published in December. Therefore please check this latest document.**

Every year that the Rally runs, it can only be done with your support and co-operation. We rely on the residents along the route of the stages for their contribution to the safe running of the event, and we thank you for that.

The event includes road closures which are the subject of both a Temporary Traffic Restriction Order and a Motor Sport Order, held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). **The roads are closed to people, animals and vehicles, unless authorised.**

Two sections of road, not often used, are closed this year:

**Glengorm Road** will be closed between the Industrial Estate and the Castle from 7:30am to 2pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October.

**Dervaig Road** from the Glengorm crossroads to Albert St on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October from 17:40 to 23:10, on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> October from 11:57 to 19:58 and then 20:46 to 05:46 (Sunday morning). This includes access to the Glengorm Road.

The main access roads (Fionnphort – Craignure – Salen-Tobermory) are never closed.

The roads close at the times listed, and this is backed up by a clearly marked vehicle with red flashing lights. Accesses are closed with tape, and this must not be broken. **The road reopens with another clearly marked vehicle "ROAD OPEN" and uses red flashing lights as a clear indication.** The road may open earlier than the published time or, by police exception, later. Ensure you have seen the road opening car before using the road.

When the road past your property is closed for the running of the stage, if you have an **emergency** and require assistance from the emergency services, please dial 999 or 112 as normal, but tell the operator the road is subject to closure for a rally. Please then contact Rally Control on the number given below. Rally Control has members of the emergency services present.

If you have no telephone, go ON FOOT to the nearest phone, or to a marshal, who will be at the junction closest to your home. Do not walk on the road. Tell the marshal your problem, they will notify the issue to our control via rally radio network.

The only way the rally can be halted is via rally control, so it is essential this process is used.

The organisers respectfully request:

- Do not attempt to drive or cycle on a closed road as you may be putting life in danger
- Ensure that any animals, especially dogs and horses, are kept safely away from the road
- Ensure that any vehicles, machinery or plant belonging to you is kept well clear of the road
- Do not tamper with any signage or tape
- Follow instructions from marshal and officials
- Share this information with your visitors, guests, carers or delivery personnel

The Mull Rally is an established event in the Island's calendar, delivering a significant economic boost. We appreciate that it is an inconvenience for many for the two days we run the event. We try to manage the rally to minimise the disruption. Again, we thank you for your co-operation and we will endeavour to minimise any inconvenience to you. We hope you have the opportunity to enjoy the event.

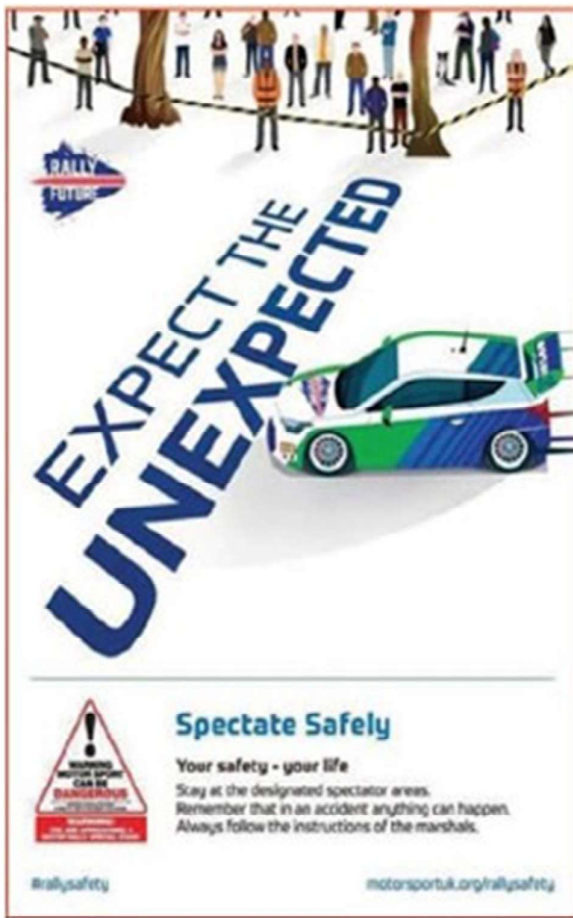
